

CALIFORNIA ADULT USE OF MARIJUANA ACT Prop 64



WHO IS ALLOWED TO USE?

Adults, age 21 or older, can legally smoke, possess, share, and consume marijuana in private, as of November 9, 2016.

PUBLIC USE?

Smoking marijuana or using marijuana products in any public place is strictly prohibited. Smoking marijuana is not allowed anywhere smoking tobacco or vaping is prohibited.



SCHOOLS?

Smoking, vaping or consuming marijuana within 1,000 ft. of schools, day care centers or youth oriented locations is prohibited.



DRIVING?

Smoking, consuming, eating or possessing an open package of marijuana while driving or riding as a passenger in any vehicle is illegal.



BUY IT?

Retail sales for non-medical marijuana use will not begin until stores can become licensed after January 2018. It is illegal to sell marijuana to another person unless you are a licensed retailer.

PRIVATE PROPERTY USE

Property owners, landlords and property management companies may ban the use and possession of marijuana on their property. This includes single family and multi-unit housing.

MEDICAL DISPENSARY USE

Smoking or vaping marijuana in a medical dispensary is not permitted under California law and prohibited in Shasta County.



WORKPLACE USE

Smoking or vaping marijuana is not allowed in any place where smoking or vaping tobacco is prohibited by state or local law. Employers are not required to make accommodations for any use of marijuana at work and in fact they can require drug testing.



YOUTH PENALTIES

Penalties for youth use and possession have changed. Most offenses by minors up to age 18 include fines, counseling, community service and drug education.



MAILING

Since marijuana is illegal at the federal level, it can't be sent through the U.S. Postal Service. Most private carriers won't allow the shipment of anything that's federally illegal.
